August 2006 – Procedure to switch NMAS to OFF in the 32bit Novell Client

This procedure should be followed by users to ensure the NMAS functionality is switched to OFF on any workstation that has the Novell 32bit client installed and is required to connect to the SAFEX Agricultural or Financial Slaves.

- 1. Locate the \mathbb{N} icon near the time display on your workstation.
- 2. Right click this icon to display the following menu
