MANUAL**

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1 INTRODUCTION

The BDA system interfaces with the Derivatives system on a nightly basis, when derivative information is uploaded into BDA, allowing for automatic journals to be passed, records of nett positions traded in the RTC and SAFEX markets to be displayed and the calculation of booking fees and VAT on all contracts.

To enable entries to be passed correctly, information has to be loaded on various BDA facilities.

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4 GETTING AROUND THE SYSTEM

4.1 Signing On To the System

The following procedure is used to sign on to the system:

When the mainframe icon is accessed the following screen will appear.

PLEASE SELECT....	Basic instructions on how to use the facility are given
NUMERIC CODE	Each system has a two digit numeric code, which is used to access the facility.
DESCRIPTION OF CODE	The name of the system to which the numeric code is linked is displayed.
PATH	The two digit numeric code of the system required may be entered in this field, e.g. 11.

Field Descriptions:

ACTN	This field is used to 'fast path' to sub-menu's or facilities. The = (equals sign) must be typed in before the code of the sub-menu or facility required.
OPTION	The codes of all BDA sub-menus are displayed.
DESCRIPTION	The description of each sub-menu is displayed.

5 BROKER MAINTENANCE (BROKM)

This facility is used to load, maintain and view the Broker loading and defaults. The facility is maintained by the Client Services Center and may only be viewed by the Brokers. This information is Broker specific except for the details pertaining to the address and telephone number.

To access this facility, select option BROKM from MENUA, or type =BROKM in the ACTN field, and press enter. A list of brokers will be displayed.

Field Descriptions:

SAFEX BRK-CDE

SAFEX BROKER CODE

This code identifies the broker as a derivatives broker who deals in futures and other derivatives. The code is issued by the Client Data division of the JSE and is issued if the broker is approved as a derivatives member. The same code will be used to trade on all the derivatives markets.

USER - SAFEX

SAFEX USER

This is a Yes/No field that indicates whether the derivative files must be uploaded into BDA for that member.

6 CONTRACT RATE TABLE (T.BKF)

This table allows for numerous combinations of SAFEX booking fee formats to be loaded. This table must be loaded before the SAFEX rate can be entered on the CLMNT facility.

To access this facility, select option BKF from the menu of available tables via MENUA, or type =T.BKF in the ACTN field and press Enter.

9 HIGH LEVEL FUNCTIONAL PROCESSING

Before the ITAC (Integrated Trading and Clearing Project) implementation BDA was receiving Margin, Deal and Position files for all the derivative markets from Nutron for EOD processing. The JSE, as part of the ITAC deliverables, has moved the Financial Equity and Currency Derivative markets to RTC (Real Time Clearing system). Commodities and the Interest Rate Derivatives will be moved to RTC at a later date.

The move of the Financial Equity and Currency Derivatives markets to RTC has resulted in changes to the processing in BDA:

- BDA will now be able to accept two sets of files for the derivative markets.
 - Nutron
 - Deals
 - Positions
 - Margins
 - RTC
 - Deals
 - Positions
 - Margins
 - A combined Margin Derivatives file across the Financial Equity and Currency Derivative markets will be received from RTC.
 - *One journal will be posted on BDA for the above markets.*
 - The transaction narrative for the journals of the Financial Equity and Currency Derivatives markets on BDA will reflect on AFINH as DERMARG PROFIT / LOSS and DERMARG MARGIN.

10 TRADING DERIVATIVES FOR NON-RESIDENT CLIENTS

When trading derivatives for Non-resident clients a certain procedure must be followed.

CLIENT

Procedure:

- A non-resident client account is opened on BDA.
- The non-resident client deposits their funds into the Equities Members non-resident bank account
- Once receipt of the funds is confirmed, the amount is credited to the client BDA account.
- The funds will automatically be swept to the JSE Trustees non-resident Trust account overnight, and will show as a credit to the client's BDA account on the T balance the same day.
- A calculation or estimate must be done as to how much margin the client will be requiring in order to trade Derivatives. A buffer, to cover daily M-T-M movements, should also be allowed for. Should the client wish for the full amount to be used for Derivative trading, obviously no estimate or calculation is required.
- The amount decided on must then be transferred via a journal entry to the F balance on the client's BDA account
- When initial margin and daily M-T-M (variation margin) and booking fees are due or is to be received (i.e. net cash-flow per the SAFEX report) which is automatically updated to BDA from SAFEX, this will show as either a debit or credit to the F balance on the client account, and the amount will sweep automatically from the JSE non-resident Trustees account to or from the Equities Member non-resident Trust account.
- All charges are debited to the income account, which will be squared off to zero at the end of each month via a transfer from the T balance to the I balance on the account. As any income accrued on a credit balance will be credited to the I balance at the end of each month, money will be transferred from the T balance to the I balance only if the account remains in debit.

Note 1: Why transfer the funds to the F balance? If this is not done, the money required to pay for margin on the FM account does not automatically sweep from the JSE Trustees non-resident account. This is a control implemented by the JSE on non-resident accounts in order to ensure that the Equities Member does not fund the trading done by the non-resident client.

Note 2: Why transfer the full amount to the F balance as opposed to the specific margin amount on a daily basis? For two reasons – firstly the sweep will not take place if the account is in debit, and secondly every transfer is charged for by the bank. Transferring the full amount to the F balance also has no impact on the interest received by the client – as the F balance is always included in the JSET interest calculation.

JSE SWEEPS

Procedure:

1. When the client funds are credited to Equities Members non-resident bank trust account, the funds are then swept overnight to the JSE Trustees non-resident bank account. Funds will only be swept against a BDA entry on the client account.
2. When a journal credit is put through from the T balance to the F balance on the client account, any margin amounts due or payable will automatically sweep through to the FM account, where they meet the clearing house requirements.
