# ITaC Key Dates

---



- **3 Oct 2018**
  - ITaC Market Steering Committee decision on 12 November go-live
- **6 Oct 2018**
  - Go-Live Dry Run – JSE, Clearing Members, Clearing SWP (Other SWPs –TBC)
  - Optional Dress Rehearsal however will be mandatory for those Trading Members that still need to pass a remaining MMDR
- **08 Oct – 12 Oct 2018**
  - Go Live Confirmation Cycle 1 – Mandatory clearing member go live proving test
- **17 Oct – 23 Oct 2018**
  - Go Live Confirmation Cycle 2 – Final Mandatory clearing member go live proving test
- **27 Oct 2018**
  - JSE deploys Real-Time Clearing (RTC) and Valuations Input System into production
  - Daily instrument reference data maintained in parallel to current production environment and published via new real-time Live and NLMD services daily
- **29 Oct – 9 Nov 2018**
  - Real-Time Clearing (RTC) Daily Production Runs – daily system start-up and end of day processing and logical day rollover

# Key Observations – Trading topics for discussion

---



- Market Orders (MO) - disabling Market Orders and SWP “workarounds”
  - Allows a user to get into and out of a moving market quickly and with confidence
  - During regular trading, a market order to buy (sell) executes with the sell (buy) side of the order book starting from the lowest (highest) available price and moving on to the highest (lowest) available price in the book
  - 15 Sept 2018 dress rehearsal had Market Orders, Stop Orders Market If Touched and Market to Limit Orders disabled as these are all linked to Market Order functionality and cannot function independently
  - Key questions for SWPs and own solution developers
- Off Book Trade Types disabled
  - Exchange for Physical (EP) and Price Adjust (PA) - update and confirmation of Trade Sub Types
  - Seamless integration through client csv files
  - Confirm no impact
- Cancellation of orders for expired instruments
  - Order cancellation messages are not sent for instrument expiries
  - Need to understand how these are handled by software provider solutions

# Key Observations – Trading topics for discussion

---



- Failover of the trading and market data gateways
  - Short summary of failover process and questions from SWPs as to how their failover worked
- Errors raised on Order and Trade rejections during the dress rehearsals
  - Follow up on issues still occurring in dress rehearsals
- Clearing member and Back office users trading On Book
  - Permissions on trading frontends should not allow Back Office Trader IDs to do this
  - All back office Trader IDs have “Back Office” in the Surname field
- Clients do not understand the symbology / instrument codes on their frontends.
  - Need to encourage clients to engage with their SWP’s to understand.
- Segregation of different desks
  - Follow up on issues still occurring in dress rehearsals

# Key Observations – Trading topics for discussion

- Errors raised on Order and Trade rejections during the dress rehearsals
  - Follow up on issues still occurring in dress rehearsals
- Clearing member and Back office users trading On Book
  - Permissions on trading frontends should not allow Back Office Trader IDs to do this
  - All back office Trader IDs have “Back Office” in the Surname field



# Key Observations – Clearing Topics for discussion



- Client maintenance – loading of a foreign / non-resident client
  - JSE will now pre-load a member cash account for all members firms who do not currently have a cash account loaded to allow all members to add foreign clients
  - JSE observed that the foreign client loading process in software provider solutions is not always intuitive resulting in users not loading the cash accounts which prevents the JSE from enabling these clients in some cases
- Commissions reference fields
  - **Commissions reference fields are still not being populated correctly in all cases**
  - Issues were identified in the focused testing in End to End from 4-7 September and JSE were provided to each software provider
  - **Software providers are requested to urgently address these if issues** if they haven't already or contact the JSE if the issues identified need clarification or discussion
  - A second focussed test is planned for week 2 of E2E cycle 5 i.e. next week
- Commissions scenarios
  - An additional scenario is being investigated on the back of a request by a member which involves charging the counterparty member/branch on a reported trade a commission

# Optional Market Dress Rehearsal – 6 Oct 2018

---



- **Key objectives** of the Go-Live Dry Run for the Equity Derivatives and Currency Derivatives Markets
  - Practice the go live cut-over activities and timings as they will occur on the weekend of go live i.e. the position take-on process will only start on Friday evening after market close
  - This means the dress rehearsal on 6 Oct is only expected to start at approx. 12 noon – exact schedule times will be communicated in due course
- **Participation requirements**
  - **Mandatory** for all Clearing Members
  - **Mandatory** for all clients that have not yet achieved the min of 2 dress rehearsal pass criteria
  - **Optional** Dress Rehearsal for other clients not mentioned above
