Dress Rehearsal Results Overall

- Minimum of 2 dress rehearsal pass for Trading and Live Market Data
 - All Trading Members for both EDM and FXM
 - All Clearing Members (for OBO)
 - All real-time Information Subscribers
 - All Trading and Clearing Members have tested current TraderIDs (except for 5 IDs)

- Minimum of 2 dress rehearsal pass for Post-trade
 - All Trading Members and Clearing Members except 1

- Enablement Freeze Period
 - Any new/changed enablements between now and go-live must pass 2 dress rehearsals (9Feb/9Mar)
 - 9 Feb 2019 Enablement change freeze start
 - 6 May 2019 Enablement change freeze end (could be earlier if bedding down period smooth)
- TraderID Freeze Period
 - 9 Mar 2019 TraderID freeze start
 - 15 Apr 2019 TraderID freeze end
- Go Live Bedding Down Period
 - 8 Apr 6 May 2019

Clearing EOD Processes

EOD processes and indicative timings



- Client specific data files (ED.zip and CD.zip) can only be produced and made available in the evening once all the constituent data records have been successfully produced
- There will be material changes to the upstream routines that produce the source input data number of routines, start times and duration of routines
- Due to clients being able to create intra day instruments until 18h30, the JSE has can only perform valuations on all derivative instruments post certain EOD activities
- The ETE environment has been operating with test data and it has been difficult to project the actual volume of data that will be involved post go-live and its impact on all the upstream routines and timings of these

For all these reasons, the JSE has decided to set the SLA time for the End of Day Non-Live Market Data products to 20:30 SAST from 8 Apr 2019

Post production go-live, the JSE will review the actual average data file availability times and review the SLA time (if possible)
