D3 CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS D30

- D11 Dairy Products**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing dairy products i.e. butter, cheese, ice cream, milk, etc.
- D12 Bakery Products**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of the bread, pastry and pastry products, cookies, and frozen bakery products.
- D13 Sugar and Confectionery Products**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of sugar, candy, chocolate, cocoa products, chewing gum etc.
- D20 Brewers**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of beer, ale and stout.
- D21 Distillers and Vintners**
Establishments engaged in the manufacturing of the whisky, brandy, gin, liquors, rum and wine.
- D22 Soft Drinks and Mineral Waters**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of the soft drinks and mineral waters.
- D30 Soap, Detergents and Cleaning Preparations**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing soap, detergents, as well as furniture, metal and other polishes.



D4 TOBACCO

D5 FURNITURE AND FIXTURES

D31 Industrial Chemicals
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing industrial chemicals, industrial gases, fibres, coatings and paints.

D32 Pharmaceuticals
Companies involved in research, development, exploitation and distribution of pharmaceutical products, as well as those that derive majority of their revenue from the sale, and/ or licensing of these drugs, or both.

D33 Personal Products
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing perfumes (natural and synthetic), cosmetics, and other toilet preparations.

D40 Tobacco Products
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of cigarettes, cigars and other tobacco products i.e. chewing tobacco.

D50 Household Furniture
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of various household furniture such as beds, tables, couches etc.

D51 Office Furniture
Establishments primarily in the manufacturing of various household furniture such as tables, chairs, filing cabinets etc.

D7 INDUSTRIAL

- D52 Furniture Integrated**
Establishments engaged in the manufacturing of household and office furniture.
- D60 Steel**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing of the basic steel products including refining, rolling, drawing and alloying, as well as smelting in blast furnaces.
- D61 Nonferrous Metals**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing of the basic nonferrous metal products, as well as refining, rolling, drawing and extruding of the nonferrous metals.
- D70 Farm Machinery and Equipment**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing of the farm machinery and equipment such as wheel tractors, and any operations and processes.
- D71 Construction Machinery and Equipment**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of heavy machinery and equipment used primarily.
- D72 Industrial Trucks, Trailers and Stackers**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing industrial trucks, tractors, trailers, stackers (truck type), and related equipment, used for handling material on floors and paved surfaces in and around industrial and commercial plants, depots, docks, airports and terminals.



D8 ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT AND COMPONENTS

- D73 Diversified Industrial**
Establishments engaged in manufacturing of more than one industrial product subcategory.
- D74 Other**
Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacturing of industrial products not mentioned elsewhere.
- D80 Electrical Equipment**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing machinery, apparatus, and supplies for the generation, storage, transformation, and utilization of electrical energy.
- D81 Household Appliance**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing household electric and non electric cooking equipment, such as stoves, ranges and ovens.
- D82 Household Audio and Video Equipment**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing electronic audio and video equipment for home entertainment (including automotive), such as television sets, radio broadcast receivers, tape players, phonographs, and video recorders and players.



D9 TRANSPORTATION EQUIPMENT

- D83 Computer Hardware**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing of computer hardware and/ or electronic components and/or accessories.
- D84 Other**
Establishments engaged in the manufacturing of electronic and electrical equipment and components not classified elsewhere.
- D90 Motor Vehicle Parts and Accessories**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing motor vehicle parts and accessories (except Tyres and inner Tubes D92), but not engaged in manufacturing complete motor vehicles or passenger car bodies.
- D91 Motor Vehicles**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing or assembling complete passenger automobiles, trucks, commercial cars and busses, and special purpose motor vehicles which are for highway use.
- D92 Tyres and Inner Tubes**
Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing pneumatic casings, inner tubes, and solid and cushion tires for all types of vehicles, airplanes, farm equipment, and children's vehicles; tiring camelback and tire repair and retreading materials



E SERVICES

E1 TRANSPORTATION

E10 Rail, road and Freight

Establishments primarily engaged in land transportation of cargo and passengers, and all related facilities and services, including road and tunnel operators, as well as the agencies that undertake transportation of goods.

E11 Transportation by Air and Airlines

This major group includes establishments engaged in furnishing domestic and foreign transportation by air of cargo and passengers, and also those operating airports and flying fields and furnishing terminal services.

E12 Water Transportation and Ports

Establishments engaged in freight and passenger transportation on the open seas or inland waters, and establishments furnishing such incidental services as lighterage, towing, and canal operation. Entities providing terminal facilities and related services also fall under this classification.

E13 Transportation Integrated

Establishments engaged in more than one transportation subcategory i.e. Water transportation and air transportation.

E2 COMMUNICATION

E20 Land Telecommunications

Establishments primarily engaged in furnishing land telecommunication networks.



E3 UTILITIES

E4 SUPPORT SERVICES

E21 Wireless Telecommunication

Establishments primarily engaged in furnishing cellular telephone services, telephone paging and beeper services, and those engaged in leasing telephone lines or other methods of telephone transmission, such as optical fiber lines and microwave or satellite facilities and reselling the use of such methods to others.

E30 Electricity Services

Establishments engaged in the generation, transmission and/ or distribution of natural gas.

E31 Gas Production and Distribution

Establishments engaged in the transmission and/or storage and/or distribution of natural gas.

E32 Water Supply

Establishments primarily engaged in distributing water for sale for domestic, commercial, and industrial use.

E40 Business Support Services

Establishments engaged in a wide range of business support services, including printing services, management consultants, office cleaning services, training courses, employment services or other similar services not mentioned elsewhere in this document.



F	WHOLESALE TRADE	F1	DURABLE GOODS	F10	Motor Establishments primarily engaged in the wholesale distribution of automobiles and other motor vehicles, new and spare vehicle parts, as well as tyres and tubes.
				F11	Furniture Establishments primarily engaged in the wholesale distribution of furniture, including bedsprings, mattresses and other household furniture; office furniture; and furniture for public parks and buildings.
				F12	Construction Materials Establishments primarily engaged in the wholesale distribution of various construction materials encompassing timber, brick stone, roofing, etc.

				G11	Variety Stores Establishments primarily engaged in the retail sale of a variety of merchandise in the low and popular price ranges. Sales are usually made on a cash-and-carry basis, with the open-selling method of display and customer selection of merchandise. These stores generally do not carry a complete line of merchandise, are not departmentalized.
