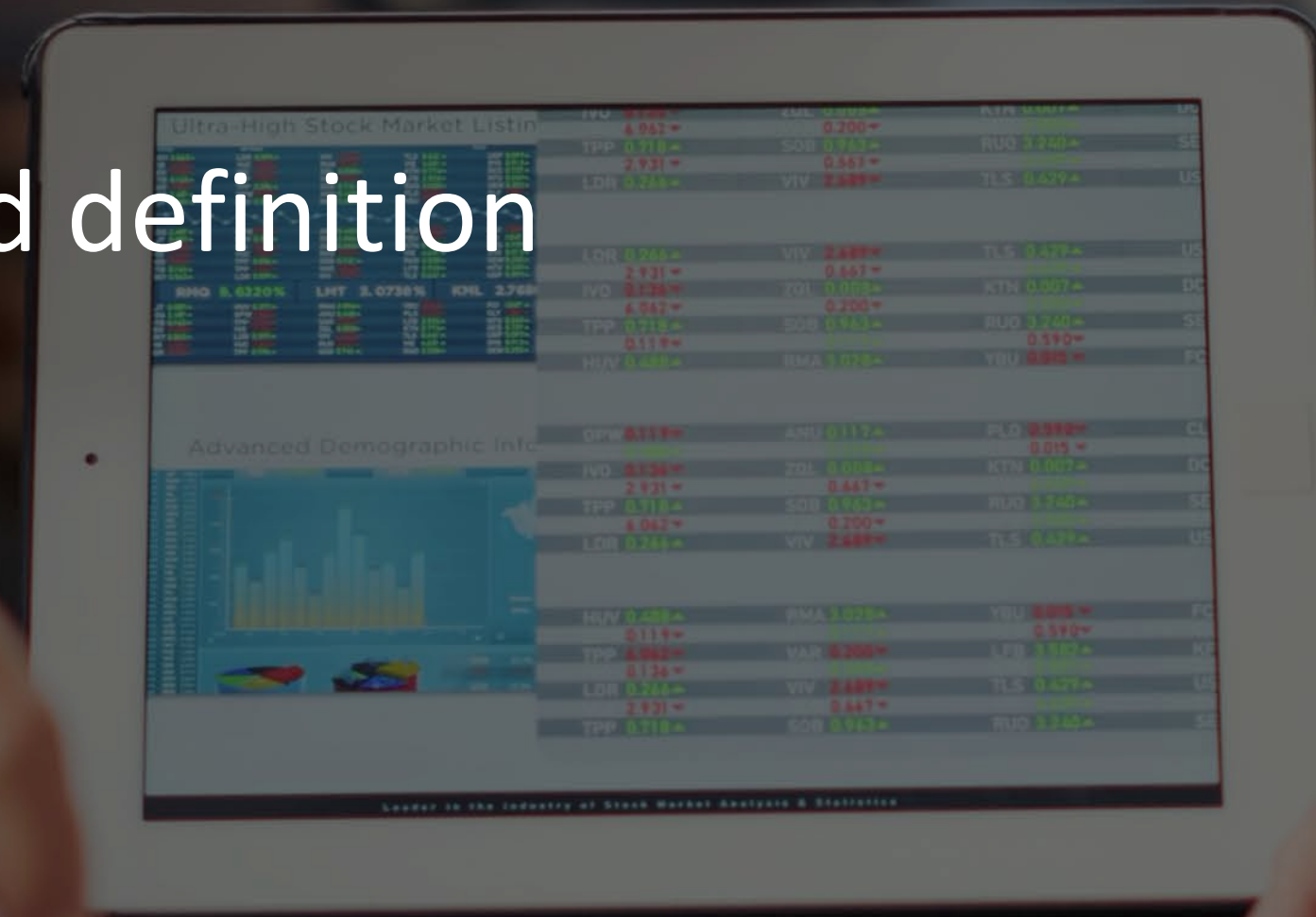

## Introduction

This policy is intended to provide guidance to users with regards to the distribution of live data through mobile devices.





## Definitions





## Definitions

- a. A mobile device is a portable handheld device that could store, create, organise, manipulate and otherwise display the data in one or more forms.
- b. A mobile device typically receives and sends data through wireless communications, without necessarily needing to be permanently linked/connected to any particular network and/or physical location.

## Examples of a Mobile Device

Cellular/mobile phones, smart phones, personal digital assistants and pager devices.  
**Tablets** are specifically excluded from the definition of mobile device.

## Conditions

1. Other than in relation to the stated examples under the definition of mobile device above and any other device types which the JSE has approved in writing as mobile devices, contracted users are required to get the approval of the JSE before classifying and reporting a device type as a mobile device.
2. This policy applies only to equities live level 1 and level 2 data and live derivatives data. In terms of the live derivatives data, this policy only applies to professional end users. In relation to all other data types, the contracted user must pay the standard end user fees.





## Conditions

3. A professional end user paying the live data terminal fee for the data permitted under this policy will be allowed access to the same data through a mobile device at no additional cost, provided that the professional end user is not able to access that data through both devices concurrently.
4. The contracted user is liable for both a terminal fee and a mobile device fee for professional end users that have concurrent access.
